Business arising from last meeting

- None

BIP Updates

- Nothing significant on BIP
- Various plants on BIP planned shutdown later in 2015
- BIP website hopes to be online by October 2015

Qenos

- Olefines
 - No injuries
 - Effluent improvement – putting process effluent in cooling tower instead of sewer
 - Site Utilities bag assembly performing well, i.e. stabilised steam supply
 - Esso restricted ethane such that it impacted on Qenos operations in Victoria and the plastics industry generally
- Alkathene & Alkatuff
 - Alkathene has 1879 days injury-free including contractors and staff
 - Alkatuff 726 days injury-free
 - Significant shutdown planned for late 2015
 - New product on Alkatuff line. It ran for 3 weeks and then returned to normal products. This change over resulted in a controlled flare. This was self reported to the authorities, but is not considered a breach.

Huntsman

- 1877 days injury-free
- In February 2015, 2 milestones were achieved – 5000 days and 3000 days for the packaging group
- Good production rates helped by the lower Australian dollar

Orica

- No representative

Ixom

- Now operates ChlorAlkali Plant and the Groundwater Treatment Plant
- GTP is operated on toll on behalf of Orica

Transfield

- Introduced Tony Gaynor as the new HSE Advisor, who was with Caltex previously
- Shutdown teams will be located in the old SHE Pacific building at Gate 4
- Getting ready for the shutdown in October 2015, preparation has commenced

Industrial Neighbours

- Orora
 - Proposed demolition work, expecting to award contract at the end of April 2015

Community Response

- Question on behalf of Ross Salter asked about whether Dangerous Goods truck movements are considered by BIP operations managers
 - Operations managers have received a report from Port Botany and are now considering implications of Dangerous Goods truck movements along Denison Street that could impact BIP
- BIP subdivision consent conditions
 - Is there transparency in conditions
 - Original consent conditions now being reviewed as many of the original are now not applicable
- BIP contributed \$15,000 to develop Emergency Procedures app
 - No progress but will be followed up
- Lynda Newnam has been pursuing emergency procedures for the Botany area
 - Unsatisfactory response from authorities
 - Conveyed message from Carlos that he was disappointed that there is a lack of action on local area emergency management procedures

Authority Updates

City of Botany Bay Council

- Council is restructuring
- New planning and environment director
- No complaints received by Council regarding BIP

Sydney Water

- 2 trade waste agreements – 14th Avenue and Olefines
- 14th Avenue has an Effluent Improvement Program (EIP) due for May 2015 completion
- Olefines has a Benzene improvement program
- Improved performance is indicating that it is now trending from a Risk Index 2 to a low Risk Index 5
- There was discussion on Sydney Water's EPA licence and quality of discharge
 - Control strategies employed by SWC to manage substances concentrations and quantities.
 - Limits of effluent from customers impacted by SWC's EPA licence and safety of SWC employees
 - It was suggested that the pending BIP website be used to convey such information to help educate community
